



TerraNova Testing

Dear St. Frances Cabrini Parents and Families,

Next week, grades 3-8 will be taking the TerraNova Test. The TerraNova is a series of standardized achievement tests designed to assess student achievement in reading, language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. Please note that, according to our Policies and Procedures, Standardized testing is a requirement for all students at certain grade levels and that “opting out” is not an option.

It is **extremely important** that your child is present, on time, and prepared with a good night’s sleep, healthy breakfast, and No. 2 pencil for the test. Tests will begin at exactly 8:30 am every morning and will go until 11:30 with periodic breaks. Any student that arrives after 8:30 am will be sent to the cafeteria until testing is over. As a reminder, we stop serving breakfast at 7:55.

(Need to be at school by 7:55 to get school breakfast) • Student need a No. 2 pencil and eraser (mechanical pencils are not allowed)
