Dear Parents and Families,

It was good to get back into our routine this week after Terranova! Thank you for working to make sure your children were here, on time, and ready to go for testing! We've noticed that as the year has gone on students have not been adhering to the uniform policy. As a reminder, students need to wear all black shoes or saddle shoes. Sneakers with other colors and boots are not allowed. Headbands must be colors that complement our school uniform. Bandanas, colored and novelty headbands are not allowed.
