Reminders/Updates

- **Summer school letters will be going home this week.** Any student who is failing one or more classes for the year or who has missed 20 or more days of school is required to go to summer school. Summer school is free of cost and will run Monday-Thursday from 8:00-12:00 for five weeks. (June 24-July 25)
- Any **SFC family who refers a new family to St. Frances Cabrini** will get a **\$25 dollar Flynn and O'Hara gift card** when they enroll.
- **MAP testing window is from May 6 through May 24.** Students in K-8 will take their final round of Reading and Math MAP tests so we can see how much they've grown!
- **Any student who arrives at school before 7:30 must be registered for CARES.** Students who are not in Cares can arrive after 7:30.
